## DRUG TAKE BACK DAY

October 28, 2023

No businesses allowed. All waste pharmaceuticals must be generated by a household.

**What to bring:** Prescription drugs (controlled and non-controlled) and over-the-counter medications, ointments, patches, non-aerosol sprays, inhalers, creams, vials and pet medications.

**Do no bring:** Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, aerosol cans, bio-hazardous materials (anything containing bodily fluid or blood), mercury thermometers, personal care products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreens, etc....) household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas).

**Participants may:** dispose of solid, non-liquid medication(s) by removing the medication from its container and disposing of it directly into a disposal box or into a clear sealable plastic bag. Plastic pill containers should not be collected. Blister packages are acceptable without the medications being removed. Liquids will be accepted during this initiative. However, the liquids, creams and sprays must be in their original packaging and evenly dis-tributed within the boxes of collected solid prescriptions. Liquids without the original pack-aging will not be accepted.

Illicit substances such as a marijuana or methamphetamine are not a part of this initiative and should not be placed in the collection containers.

ATTENTION: All participants must retain possession of their own medications during the surrender process. Law enforcement personnel should *not* handle the medications at any time.
