### **ORDINANCE NO. 01-2025**

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMENDING SECTION 6-6 (1) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF OPERATORS LICENSE BY THE VILLAGE CLERK

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PRAIRIE, WAUKESHA, WISCONSIN,

DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1:** Section 6-6 (1) of the Village Code of the Village of North Prairie is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision:

Village Board approval of Operator Licenses under this article shall not be required, provided however, the Village Clerk in the Clerk's discretion may refer any application to the Village Board for review and approval.

Discretionary points to be brought before the Village Board are as follows:

- a) Underage serving violation less than 2 years
- b) OWI less than 2 years
- c) Drug related violations less than 2 years
- d) Untruthful on Operator License application

**SECTION 2:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with or contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3**: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

The person's successor shall take office upon his or her election or appointment and qualification and shall hold office for the term prescribed under s. 83.01 (2).

(d) In the office of any other officer appointed by the county board, by temporary appointment by the chairperson of the county board. A person so appointed shall hold office until a successor is appointed and qualifies, and the successor shall be appointed by the county board for the residue of the unexpired term at its meeting next after such vacancy occurred.

17.23 Vacancies in city offices; how filled. (1) GENERAL AND SPECIAL CHARTER CITIES. (am) Except as provided in sub. (1b) and s. 9.10, vacancies in offices of mayor or alderperson of cities operating under the general law or special charter may be filled by the common council, by majority vote, appointing a successor to serve for the residue of the unexpired term or until a special election is held, as ordered by the common council under s. 8.50, or an office may remain vacant until an election is held.

(bm) In the office of municipal judge, in the manner provided in s. 8.50 (4) (fm).

(c) In the office of any other elective officer, and except as provided in s. 9.10, by appointment by the mayor subject to confirmation by the common council, for the residue of the unexpired term unless a special election is ordered by the common council, except that in case of vacancies in the office of any such officer of a 1st class city who is authorized by law to have a deputy, such deputy shall perform the duties of such office, and shall be entitled to the emoluments of such office during the remainder of the term. A person so appointed and confirmed shall hold office until a successor is elected and qualifies. The successor shall be elected as provided in par. (a).

NOTE: Section 17.23 (1) (a) was repealed by 2019 Wis. Act 164.

- (1b) FIRST CLASS CITIES. In 1st class cities, in the office of mayor, except as provided in s. 9.10, the vacancy shall be filled by the president of the common council as acting mayor until a special election can be held. In such case, the acting mayor may continue to serve as president of the common council, in addition to exercising the powers and responsibilities of the office of mayor, until such time as a new mayor is elected and qualified, but the acting mayor may not take part in any vote of the common council during that period. A vacancy in the office of alderperson shall be filled by special election, except as provided in s. 9.10. When a mayor is temporarily appointed, the common council shall order a special election for the office of mayor under s. 8.50 as promptly as possible, unless the vacancy occurs within 120 days of the expiration of the mayor's term of office. When an aldermanic seat becomes vacant, a successor shall be elected for the residue of the unexpired term, but no election to fill a vacancy in such office may be held at the time of holding the regular election for that office. The president of the common council of any 1st class city shall order a special election to be held under s. 8.50 to fill a vacant aldermanic seat. If a special election is held under this subsection after a redistricting plan is adopted, the election shall be held in the aldermanic district as it existed when the office was filled at the last preceding election.
- (1m) APPOINTIVE OFFICES. Vacancies in appointive offices in cities may be filled by appointment for the residue of the unexpired term by the appointing power and in the manner prescribed by law for making regular full term appointments thereto.
  - (2) COMMISSION FORM. Vacancies in offices of cities operat-

ing under the commission form of government shall be filled as follows:

- (a) 1. In the office of mayor or other member of the council, except as provided in s. 9.10, in the manner provided in sub. (1) (am). In the office of municipal judge, in the manner provided in s. 8.50 (4) (fm). On failure of the council to make an appointment for 30 days after the vacancy exists the city engineer shall be a temporary acting member of the council until such vacancy is filled in the manner provided by law, and shall have all the powers, prerogatives and duties of the vacant office except the right to vote to fill a vacancy in the office of mayor or council member.
- 2. When 2 vacancies exist in the council the city clerk shall be a temporary acting member of the council until the vacancies are filled in the manner provided by law, and shall have all the powers, prerogatives and duties of the vacant office except the right to vote to fill a vacancy in the office of mayor or council member.
- 3. When 3 vacancies exist in the council the city treasurer shall be a temporary acting member of the council until the vacancies are filled in the manner provided by law, and shall have all the powers, prerogatives and duties of the vacant office except the right to vote to fill a vacancy in the office of mayor or council member.
- 4. When 2 or more vacancies exist in the council 6 months or more prior to the first Tuesday of April of any year a special election to fill the vacancy for the residue of the unexpired term of each such vacancy shall be held and conducted, and the returns thereof made in the manner and within the time required in the case of regular municipal elections, and the city clerk shall call and give notice of such special election as provided by law within 10 days of the date when such vacancies exist.
- 5. While serving as temporary members of the council the city engineer, city clerk and city treasurer shall not be entitled to have or receive any compensation for such temporary service.
- 6. The powers, prerogatives and duties conferred on such temporary acting members of the council shall be in addition to all those otherwise vested by law in such city engineer, city clerk and city treasurer.
- 7. It is hereby declared to be the purpose and intention of this paragraph to permit the city engineer, city clerk and city treasurer to have and perform the powers and duties herein provided as temporary acting members of the council, in addition to the regular powers and duties of their respective offices and notwithstanding any other contrary provision of the law.
- 8. This paragraph shall apply only to cities organized and operating under ss. 64.25 to 64.38.
- (c) In appointive offices, by appointment for the residue of the unexpired term by the appointing power and in the manner prescribed by law for making regular full term appointment thereto.

A vacancy in an appointive office shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.

#### **CONTRACT**

This contract entered into this 12h day of March, 2025, by and between WOLVERINE FIREWORKS DISPLAY, INC., hereinafter referred to as "WOLVERINE" A Michigan Company, duly licensed by the BATFE, and Village of North Prairie-Harvest Festival, hereinafter referred to as "Sponsor".

- 1. Wolverine agrees to furnish Sponsor, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein, One (1) fireworks display as per this signed and accepted contract. This will include trained and qualified Pyrotechnicians to deliver, setup, execute and take down the pyrotechnic display.
- 2. Wolverine agrees to provide insurance coverage of Ten Million Dollars, Bodily Injury and Property Damage and the statutory limits for Worker's Compensation Insurance. The Sponsor will be named as additional insured on the certificate. This insurance covers the operations of Wolverine only and does not extend to any other aspect of the event.
- 3. The date of this display is: Sept. 13th, 2025 at: Cpm. In the event of inclement weather, the display will be rescheduled for the next night | 1/2 | 2/5 | at no additional cost to the Sponsor (dates around the 4th of July are excluded unless approved by Wolverine). In the event the display is rescheduled to a date not the next night, there will be an additional 15% cost added to the contract amount to cover additional expenses involved. In the event the Sponsor does not choose to reschedule another date or cannot agree to a mutually convenient date, the Sponsor shall pay the Contractor an amount equal to 40% to cover Wolverine's cost, damages, and expenses.
- 4. The cost of the display is: \$5000.00 including hazmat fee plus tax (unless exempt). A deposit in the amount of: \$2500.00 shall be made upon signing of contract, no later than 90 days prior to display date. If the display is cancelled by sponsor after deposit is paid but prior to 30 days before the display, Sponsor will forfeit 25% of deposit. If display is cancelled by Sponsor 30 days prior to display or after, Sponsor will forfeit 100% of deposit.
- 5. The balance due shall be paid to Wolverine within 10 days following the display.
- 6. A 2.5% Hazardous Material Handling fee of \$125.00 Included in display budget will be added to the invoice (based on the display cost) along with any permit fees paid by Wolverine. There will be a 1.5% late charge added to the invoice on any outstanding amount not paid in full by the agreed upon date.
- 7. Sponsor, at Sponsor's expense, agrees to provide Wolverine with a suitable display site that meets the guidelines as set forth in NFPA 1123 and meeting the approval of Wolverine. All permits necessary for the display shall be the responsibility of the Sponsor. All necessary police, fire, and other appropriate protection necessary for proper crowd control, automobile parking, and display site security will be the responsibility of the Sponsor and in accordance with the provisions of NFPA 1123.
- 8. After the display, Wolverine will conduct a post display search of the area/fallout zone for any unexploded fireworks. Sponsor explicitly acknowledges that an early morning first light search of the Display Site as defined in NFPA 1123 is of utmost importance and the search will be conducted by the Sponsor. If any unexploded shells or devices are found, Wolverine will be contacted immediately to

- properly disposed of said material. Wolverine will be responsible for the removal of all equipment provided by Wolverine. Sponsor will be responsible for any remaining cleanup that may be required after the display.
- 9. Sponsor agrees to defend and hold Wolverine harmless from and against all claims and any penalties, damages, and costs made against and/or incurred by Wolverine in the event (1) the display does not commence on the date and time contemplated by this contract or is otherwise disrupted because of equipment or product malfunction or failure, and/or (2) Sponsor's breach of its obligations under the contract.
- 10. The laws of the State of Wisconsin shall govern this contract. Nothing in this contract shall be construed as forming a partnership between the Sponsor and Wolverine. Neither party shall be held responsible for any agreements nor obligations not expressly provided for herein and shall be severally responsible for their own separate debts and obligations.
- 11. If Wolverine, in its sole determination, is unable to supply the size and type of fireworks proposed due to supply chain issues, Wolverine will substitute with fireworks of equal monetary value, in its sole discretion, if possible. If no such supply is available, Wolverine will refund Sponsor any deposit paid, and this agreement will be cancelled without penalty to Wolverine or Sponsor.
- 12. This contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and shall be binding on the parties, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

RE Intermunicipal Agreement concerning the Kettle Moraine Fire District ("Agreement")

## Dear Clerks:

The Protective Services Committee for the Village of North Prairie has conducted a three (3) year audit of the usage of the Kettle Moraine Fire Department by the Village of North Prairie ("VNP"), the Town of Eagle ("TOE") and the Village of Eagle ("VOE"), which includes years 2022, 2023 and 2024.

Per the audit, the average usage of the KMFD by each municipality during this three (3) year period (which is inclusive of mutual aid calls being evenly split by three) is as follows:

24% Village of North Prairie

32% Village of Eagle

44% Town of Eagle

Pursuant to Article V.I.2.c.(1), the current financial formula for the distribution of costs is as follows ("Financial Formula"):

37% Village of North Prairie

21% Village of Eagle

42% Town of Eagle

The above information reflects quite a discrepancy in the cost of the KMFD to each municipality to the actual usage by each municipality. This places an unfair burden on the taxpayers of North Prairie.

The Village of North Prairie is hereby respectively requesting a review of the Financial Formula pursuant to Article V.I.2.c.(3). In addition, the VNP is requesting the VNP, TOE and VOE begin discussions by May 1, 2025, to adjust the Financial Formula to distribute the cost of the KMFD more equitable between the three municipalities and amend the amend the Agreement appropriately.

Please also forward this letter to your respective attorneys in accordance with Article XII.E of the Agreement.

The Village of North Prairie is and remains committed to the KMFD, its fire professionals and its success. The Village Board of North Prairie looks forward to working with the respective Boards of Village of Eagle and Town of Eagle to reach a resolution that is fair and equitable to each community.

## North Prairie Athletic Association (NPAA) Athletic Field Use Agreement With

## The Village of North Prairie - 2025

This agreement is entered between the Village of North Prairie, a municipal entity duly created and existing under the laws of Wisconsin (hereinafter "North Prairie") and North Prairie Athletic Association (hereinafter "NPAA"). Upon consideration of the compensation, benefits, services and mutual promises described herein the adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged by all parties and intending to be bound, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- Subject property: This agreement encompasses the Baseball/Softball and Soccer Fields located at Prairie Village Park, Broadlands Park and Veterans Park in the Village of North Prairie, WI.
- 2. <u>Term</u>: Term of this agreement shall be one year and runs concurrent with the calendar year. A new agreement shall be signed annually by both parties.
- 3. Payments and other Compensation:
  - a. No payment shall be made provided the NPAA handles all field/diamond set-up which includes: costs of lime chalk, cost of spray paint, labor, clean up and any other ancillary costs associated.
  - b. All fields must be cleaned up and left in ready to use condition after each use, including practices and games.
- 4. <u>Schedule of Dates Reported:</u> NPAA is responsible to provide schedules as noted below. Failure to report schedules may result in fields not being reserved for use by NPAA.
  - a. Spring Soccer schedule to be to North Prairie no later than 3/1
  - b. All baseball/softball schedules to be to North Prairie no later than 5/1.
  - c. Fall Soccer schedule to be to North Prairie no later than 8/1
- 5. <u>Use of Subject Property for Practice and Games:</u> NPAA shall be entitled to the use of athletic fields, restrooms, parking and grass areas at the above noted locations for both practices and games. North Prairie will not schedule or authorize organized use of the subject property by any individuals, groups or organizations during the subject property being used for practice or games through proper reservation notification. North Prairie cannot be responsible for incidental use that may occur by private citizens.
- 6. <u>Use of Kubota, Drag and other Field Prep Equipment:</u> The Village will allow the use of equipment required to drag and maintain the ball diamonds provided the following requirements are met:
  - a. A DPW representative must train and authorize any users of this equipment to ensure they understand how to run all aspects of the equipment, transporting equipment and best practices for dragging the fields. A list of approved operators will be kept by the Village Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer as well as with the DPW.
  - b. The NPAA **MUST** provide a Certificate of Insurance, naming the Village of North Prairie as an additional insured on their insurance policy.
  - c. The NPAA **MUST** provide a Waiver of Sub-litigation to cover bodily harm, property and/or equipment damage.

- 7. <u>Use of Concession Stands at Subject Properties:</u> NPAA will have first right of refusal of concession stand usage, annually. Should they decline and another organization approaches North Prairie they may be granted use of the concession stand so long as proper licensure is obtained through the Village of North Prairie. Alcohol sales must be approved through Road, Buildings and Grounds Committee. Should alcohol sales be allowed it must be purchased through a licensed distributor and sold per WI State Statues. No carry-in alcohol may be sold at any park.
- 8. Items stored in the Storage Units and/or Concession Stand: NPAA shall only store food and beverage related items in the concession stand. Any other items stored in the concession area will need approval from North Prairie. North Prairie is not responsible for product spoilage due to power outage, equipment breakdown or malfunction. NPAA shall have full use and control over storage facilities they own which includes storage structures at Prairie Village Park, Veterans Park and Broadlands Park. North Prairie agrees to store, in the DPW facility on Oakridge Dr., lime chalk and spray paint purchased by NPAA.
- 9. <u>Care of Facilities:</u> Use of baseball/softball and soccer fields and storage units are subject to these facilities being kept in clean, sanitary and safe conditions at all times.
- 10. <u>Maintenance and Cleaning Obligations:</u> The parties shall have the following maintenance and cleaning obligations throughout the term of this agreement:
  - a. North Prairie shall be solely responsible for the following at all times during this agreement period:
    - Maintaining garbage containers in adequate condition to reasonably secure the items placed in the containers. This includes providing adequate size bags and rubber bands for restock use.
    - II. Preparing diamonds/fields throughout each season by mowing and grass/weed control by fencing and garbage removal. NPAA, should empty a rubbish container when it becomes full. They will remove the full bag and place it next to the container and restock the container with a new bag/band.
    - III. Maintenance and/or repair of areas where topsoil and grass seed are needed. Diamond mix, as required, will also be North Prairies' responsibility to purchase and distribute throughout diamonds.
- 11. NPAA shall be solely responsible for the following at all times during this agreement:
  - a. Diamond/field lining and prep for practices and games.
  - b. Will check all bathrooms after use to be sure rubbish is disposed of properly. Where flush toilets are located to check to be sure all toilets are flushed, assure no faucets are left running and lights are turned off.

## **Contract for Lawn Mowing**

This agreement is entered between the Village of North Prairie, a municipal entity duly created and existing under the laws of Wisconsin (hereinafter "Village") and Prairie Village Water Trust (hereinafter "PVWT").

Whereas, the Village owns and operates lawn mowing equipment and provides desirable and mandated services to residents and property owners within it corporate limits; and

Whereas, PVWT desires the Village to provide identical services to property within certain specified areas of the Village as the Village provides within its own corporate limits; and

Whereas, the Village President and PVWT Trustee have recommended to the North Prairie Village Board and the Prairie Village Water Trust Board consolidation of services, to some degree, to efficiently provide lawn mowing control in the Village and Water Trust Parcels; and

Whereas, the Prairie Village Water Trust Board and the Village Board find that this recommendation of shared services will provide a cost savings to the Water Trust, will provide income to the Village, will allow for prompt and efficient lawn mowing control throughout the Village, and is in the best interest of the Village and PVWT.

Now, therefore, inconsideration of the mutual agreements and covenants herein contained.

## IT IS HERBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Village's Lawn Mowing Obligations: The Village hereby agrees:
  - A. The Village shall mow parcel: (hereinafter "parcel")
    - a. Parcel at 309 Karin Dr. (NPV 1568 225)
  - B. The Village shall mow the parcel in a timely fashion when mowing Village Parks.
  - C. Upon request of the PVWT, the Village shall provide additional mowing on the parcel as requested.
  - D. Commencement of mowing activities shall be at the discretion of the Village Public Works, Buildings and Grounds Committee.
- 2. <u>Village Obligation to Document Pay Requests</u>; The Village shall;
  - A. Describe the rate the PVWT is to be charged for mowing each parcel.
  - B. The described in attached Exhibit A shall not be modified for the duration of this contract except upon mutual agreement of the parties.
  - C. The Village shall provide pay requests to PVWT which shall indicate:
    - The total amount of times the Village has performed its obligations on the parcel, per this contract.
    - b. Pay requests shall be submitted quarterly for the previous quarter. Failure to submit a pay request by the required time shall not constitute breach and shall not waive the obligation of payment.
- 3. PVWT Obligation of Payment; PVWT shall:
  - A. Pay quarterly invoices within thirty (30) days of receipt.

## Contract for Snow Removal and Salting

This agreement is entered between the Village of North Prairie, a municipal entity duly created and existing under the laws of Wisconsin (hereinafter "Village") and Prairie Village Water Trust (hereinafter "PVWT").

Whereas, the Village owns and operates snow removal and salting equipment and provides desirable and mandated services to residents and property owners within it corporate limits; and

Whereas, PVWT desires the Village to provide identical services to property within certain specified areas of the Village as the Village provides within its own corporate limits; and

Whereas, the Village President and PVWT Trustee have recommended to the North Prairie Village Board and the Prairie Village Water Trust Board consolidation of services, to some degree, to efficiently provide snow removal and salt control in the Village and Water Trust Parcels; and

Whereas, the Prairie Village Water Trust Board and the Village Board find that this recommendation of shared services will provide cost savings to the Water Trust, will provide income to the Village, will allow for prompt and efficient snow removal and salting control throughout the Village, and is in the best interest of the Village and PVWT.

Now, therefore, inconsideration of the mutual agreements and covenants herein contained.

## IT IS HERBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Village's Snow Removal and Salting Obligations:</u> The Village herby agrees:
  - A. The Village shall service parcel: (hereinafter "parcel")
    - a. Parcel at E. State Rd (NPV 1568 228)
    - b. Parcel at 309 Karin Dr. (NPV 1568 225)
  - B. The Village shall plow/salt the parcel in a timely fashion when removing snow on Village streets.
  - C. Upon request of the PVWT, the Village shall provide additional snow removal and salting on the parcel as requested.
  - D. Commencement of snow removal and salting activities shall be at the discretion of the Village Public Works, Buildings and Grounds Committee.
- 2. Village Obligation to Document Pay Requests; The Village shall;
  - A. Describe the rate the PVWT is to be charged for snow removal and salting each parcel.
  - B. The described in attached Exhibit A shall not be modified for the duration of this contract except upon mutual agreement of the parties.
  - C. The Village shall provide pay requests to PVWT which shall indicate:
    - a. The total amount of times the Village has performed its obligations on the parcel, per this contract.
    - b. Pay requests shall be submitted quarterly for the previous quarter. Failure to submit a pay request by the required time shall not constitute breach and shall not waive the obligation of payment.
- 3. <u>PVWT Obligation of Payment;</u> PVWT shall:

- A. Pay quarterly invoices within thirty (30) days of receipt.
- B. Inspect work performed by the Village and notify the Village of any additional snow removal and salting through the Chair of Public Works, Buildings and Grounds.
- 4. <u>Emergency Phone Numbers:</u> For purposes of this contract, twenty-four hour communication between the Village and PVWT shall be available between parties as follows:
  - A. Water Trust Board Member:
  - B. Village Buildings and Grounds Committee Chair:
- 5. <u>Term:</u> This contract shall be for the term beginning Jan.1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025. This contract may be extended by the parties for an additional one year term by an extension agreement executed by both parties.
- 6. <u>Fuel Charges:</u> The parties acknowledge the costs and benefits can be significantly impacted by fluctuating fuel prices during the term of this contract. The parties agree to further consider the rates described in attached Exhibit A, reasonable and in good faith. In the event either party believes fluctuating fuel prices provide cause, a request to reconsider rates may be brought forward.
- 7. <u>Termination:</u> This contract shall not be unilaterally terminated by either party during the months of October, November, December, January, February, March, April and May. In other months this contract may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.
