<p>May</p>	<p>Crush it in May and focus on recycling cans. Follow these easy tips to Recycle Right and keep scrap metal out of your cart:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO recycle aluminum and steel cans and make sure they are empty, rinsed, and placed loose in your cart. Crushing is OK and can save space. • DON'T put scrap metal (car parts, pots, pans, pipes, or wires) in curbside recycling as it can damage sorting equipment. Take those items to a scrap recycler instead – they'll pay you for it, so you can make some money! <p>Not sure about an item?
